



Art 107 - Design I: 2D Summer 2022 Gestalt and Sequential Narrative

Students are prompted to create a sequential narrative, looking at principles of narrative and design set up by Scott McCloud and Ellen Lupton, using watercolor and pencil, pulling from abstract shapes that students previously developed as part of their design vocabulary.


